**Re: Pre-Qualification No. 589/2025 – Invitation to Pre-Qualify with respect to
Participation in Future Tenders for the Execution of Infra #1 Works of the Tel Aviv

Update regarding Participants’ Conference and Face to Face Meetings (“Notice”)

1. **Agenda for the Conference**

Following our notice of December 30, 2025 (the “**Conference Notice**”), the attention of the Participants is drawn to the updated and detailed agenda for the Conference attached as Annex “A” hereto.

2. **Face-to-face meetings**

- 2.1. Face-to-face meetings will be held only with those Entities which registered for such meetings as part of their Application (as defined in the Conference Notice).
- 2.2. Each session will be 45 minutes.
- 2.3. An Entity who registered for a face-to-face meeting is required to submit, by no later than **February 16, 2026**, the five (5) most fundamental issues it wishes to discuss at the meeting. Such issues shall be submitted in a dedicated email to the tender mailbox: ntapqinfra1@nta.co.il.
- 2.4. Entities who consider participating in the Pre-Qualification Process together (as part of the same Participant) may send their issues together and request to participate in the same meeting.
- 2.5. Each Entity may indicate its preferred date. The Tender Committee will attempt to accommodate such preferences, to the extent possible.
- 2.6. Following receipt of the issues from the Entity or Entities, the Tender Committee will inform each of which of the time slot allocated for its face-to-face meeting.
- 2.7. Attendance at the meeting is limited to five (5) individuals on behalf of each Entity or group of Entities (as applicable).
